

**NORTH LAKES COMMON GROUND**  
**RULES & RESTRICTIONS – Tract B**

North Lakes Homes Association (NLHOA) owns several parcels of property which are considered “common areas”. These areas primarily include both small and large lakes, Swimming Pool, and North Lakes tract B. **It is recognized that all NL members (in good standing) have access to all common ground areas.** The uses of these common grounds is limited and defined by documents located on the NorthLakesLiving web site found at:

NLHOA has established rules for the pools and lakes. This document establishes rules for the common ground related to North Lakes tract B. Tract B is the wooded area between Lake Waukomis and the large lake damn.

Tract B use restrictions:

- ✓ No storage or disposal of equipment, trailers, bicycles, waste, etc.).
- ✓ No hunting of any kind including bow, gun, trapping.
- ✓ No guns, no bows, no target practice.
- ✓ Cannot leave any trash.
- ✓ No camp fires or burning of any material.
- ✓ All guests must be accompanied in person by member in good standing (same as with lake and pool).
