

## North Lakes Home Association - Pool Policies and Rules

1. **WARNING! No lifeguard on is duty at any time.** Swim at your own risk. North Lakes Homes Association is not responsible for accidents or injuries.
2. **Children 14 years of age and under must be accompanied by a parent** or have adult supervision (18+ years old) at all times. Children should be encouraged to go to the restroom before entering the pool.
3. The pool will be open daily and the water will be tested (2) two or more times daily, by the pool committee or their designees, who have the power to close the pool.
4. The season for swimming is Memorial Day through Labor Day.
5. **Hours for the pool are 9 am to 8 pm.** If anyone would like to access the pool, before/after normal pool hours, contact the pool manager.
6. Guests must be accompanied by a resident of North Lakes in good standing. The Board reserves limiting the number of guests allowed per person.
7. The pool may be used by all members in good standing with the NLHO Association. All Homes Association assessments/dues must be paid up-to-date for any family member to use the pool facilities.
8. **Please lower umbrellas and return chairs to their proper positions prior to leaving the pool.**

## SAFETY RULES

1. **NO DIVING IS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.**
  2. Be polite and considerate - NO yelling, inappropriate public displays of affection, abusive, or foul language will not be allowed.
  3. No alcoholic beverages or glass containers of any kind are allowed in or around the pool gated area.
  4. No running, pushing or other dangerous horseplay is allowed in or around the gated area.
  5. No oversized rafts, water guns, blasters, soakers, or any water projecting mechanisms are allowed in the gated area.
  6. No swimming during rain or electrical storms.
  7. The floating rope divider must remain in place at all times.
  8. **Bather load is 25 persons.**

## HEALTH RULES

1. All swimmers must rinse off under the shower provided before entering the pool.
2. Person with any contagious disease, infectious condition (such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, carbuncles, boils, inflamed eyes, ear discharges or other conditions that appear infectious), excessive sunburn, abrasions, weeping wounds, adhesive tape, or bandages are not permitted.
3. Infants and toddlers 3 years old and under, or not toilet trained, or anyone who lacks control of urine or defecation must wear a water resistant swim diaper and waterproof swimwear. Swim diapers and waterproof swimwear must have waist and leg openings fitted such that they are in contact with the waist or leg around the entire circumference.
4. Diapers may only be changed in restrooms.
5. **NO UNSANITARY HABITS WILL BE TOLERATED.**
6. The pool will be immediately closed for cleaning in the event of a fecal or vomitus discharge. All bathers will be ordered to leave the pool until these substances are removed.
7. Proper swimming attire is required - street clothes, jean cut-offs, tennis shoes, are not to be worn in the pool.
8. No smoking is allowed in or around the pool gate area.
9. No gum chewing is allowed inside the pool gate.
10. No pets are allowed inside the pool gate.
11. All trash must be placed in the appropriate containers.

Please help everyone follow these rules so we can keep the pool open as much as possible.

**A KCMO Health Department representative DOES make regular visits to our pool.**

The NL HOA also reserves the right to deny the use of the pool to anyone at anytime.
